
Our goal for 2026 is to increase the number of diapers in each bundle from 9 to 12, or 100,956 diapers!

The St Elizabeth's Diaper Drive will run throughout Lent, from Valentine's Day until April 12th, a week after Easter.

Thanks to many generous donors St Elizabeth's distributed **75,717 diapers in 2025** to an average of 418 neighbors every Diaper Day!

A clean diaper means a happy baby, but according to data from *The NDBN Diaper Check 2023: Diaper Insecurity among U.S. Children and Families*, 1 in 2 U.S. families with young children cannot afford enough diapers to keep their infant or child clean, dry, and healthy.

These babies are more vulnerable to painful rashes and urinary tract infections and have more trips to the doctor. 1 in 4 parents miss work or school because they can't afford the diapers required to leave their baby in Childcare. *Clean diapers are a basic need of every baby and toddler.*
